Subject: Accreditation of Private School "Tempulli" in Pristina, Kosovo

the DES has taken note of

a. your written request submitted to DES on 13 November 2001 for the approval to open in Pristina the Higher Traffic Centre for Education and Studies "Tempulli", and

b. the documentation on basic features of this Higher Traffic Centre in Pristina which you presented today to the Transitional Administrative Department of Education, Science and Technology (DES) as the information back-up to your above request.

The DES issues herewith a Preliminary Authorization that allows you to open and privately operate the Higher Traffic Centre for Education and Studies "Tempulli" in Pristina until such moment that the official Kosovo law covering General and Vocational Education in Kosovo has been issued by the future Kosovo Assembly.

This does not represent a formal recognition of the education programmes offered. It rather is a preliminary measure to allow continuation of on-going educational services until legal provisions have been introduced regulating the set-up and running of private schools in Kosovo. Once the Law on General and Vocational Education has been promulgated, the UNMIK-registered founding company "Tempulli" will enter again into the process of acquiring official approval for its education activities as stipulated in the new law. It further should be noted that this preliminary agreement can only go into effect on the basis of a respective support statement from the competent technical sections of the Municipality of Pristina.
