

Based on Article 73 of the Statute of the Tempulli Academy, which is in full compliance with the law "*On higher education of the Republic of Kosovo*", issued the following:

REGULATIONS ON THE ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND DISCOUNTS

Article 1

Purpose

This regulation defines the characteristics of the regulation for allocating scholarships for students of the Temple Academy as well as determining the discounts for different categories. Students who meet the criteria set out in this regulation are entitled to benefit from scholarships and discounts of the Temple Academy.

Article 2

Scholarship and Discount Administration Commission

The Scholarship and Discounts Administration Commission is the body responsible for administering the scholarship award process and consists of the Program Coordinator, Head of Student Services and a representative from the academic staff who is elected by the Academic Council of the Tempulli Academy.

Article 3

Scholarship application procedure

Interested students must complete the scholarship form at the student office. The student office forwards the forms in question to the scholarship administration commission.

The student must submit:

- Request;
- Biography, (CV);
- Certificate on citizenship of the Republic of Kosovo (citizenship, original or certified copy) not older than 6 months;
- Birth certificate (original or certified copy) not older than 6 months.

The Scholarship Administration Committee analyzes and evaluates the application forms within seven days from the day the students fill in the forms.

For each subsequent academic year, scholarships are reviewed by the scholarship administration committee. In case of obtaining a scholarship from another institution, the student cannot benefit from a scholarship from our institution.

Article 4

Content of the scholarship

These scholarships are only valid for students who meet the admission criteria.

These scholarships are study scholarships only and do not include accommodation and food. The quoted scholarships are only valid for 6 semesters.

Students who meet the criteria to receive more than one scholarship do not benefit from all scholarships, but will only benefit from the highest scholarship.

Scholarship recipients work 120 hours of various jobs determined by the governing bodies of the Tempulli Academy (as advertisements and other work that may be assigned to them by the administrative units)

The reduction of the tuition fee will be considered a scholarship for students who gain the right to the scholarship.

Article 5

Scholarship of success

Tempulli Academy awarded 5 success scholarships to distinguished students, as follows:

- One 100% scholarship for students enrolling in the first year,
- One 75% scholarship for students enrolling in the first year,
- One 50% scholarship for second year students,
- One 50% scholarship for third year students and
- One for 50% for students in Master studies.
- To benefit from the 100% Success Scholarship, students enrolling in the first year must meet the following criteria:
- Success from High School
- National test scores,

- Documented English Language Proficiency with internationally recognized certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS
- Be active in volunteer work.
- Cover letter
- 2. To benefit from the Success Scholarship, 75% of students must meet the following criteria:
 - Success from High School
 - National test scores.
- Documented English Language Proficiency with internationally recognized certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS
 - Be active in volunteer work
 - Cover letter
- 1. To benefit from the Success Scholarship, 50% of bachelor students must meet the following criteria:
 - Average grade during studies not less than 9.0
 - Proven English language proficiency with internationally recognized certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS
 - Have high behavior and integrity while studying at the Academy
 - To participate in lectures and events which are in the interest of improving the quality of studies of the Tempulli Academy.
- 2. To benefit from the Success Scholarship, 50% of the Master students must meet the following criteria:
 - Average grade during bachelor studies not less than 9.0
 - Proven English language proficiency with internationally recognized certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS
 - Have high behavior and integrity while studying at the Academy
 - To participate in lectures and events which are in the interest of improving the quality of studies of the Tempulli Academy.
 - Work experience

Article 6

Scholarship of success in the field of transport, culture, art and sports

Students who possess a high professional training in the field of culture, arts and sports and prove this fact through the relevant documentation, on the proposal of the program coordinator and with the approval of the Board of Directors, can be awarded a scholarship in the form of a fee reduction. study.

Article 7

Causes of scholarship termination

- A student who leaves the Tempulli Academy for various reasons, loses the right to receive a scholarship from the date of departure.
- In case the student is transferred to another study program within the Tempulli Academy then he loses the right to the scholarship.
- Students who have received scholarships are required to attend at least 70% of the teaching process hours during the semester.
- Students who have received scholarships should not freeze their studies and should not take any disciplinary action

Article 8

Discount categories

Students can benefit from discounts on bachelor and master studies at the Academy according to the categories:

- 50% discount for police and their families
- 50% discount for the children of martyrs
- 10% discount for immediate payment
- 10% discount for more than two members of a family

Article 8

Entry into Force

This regulation enters into force on the day of approval by the Steering Council.

Article 9

Implementation

Implementation of this regulation is ensured by the Director of the Academy.
